

**EDUNET GED Instruction**  
**FACT SHEET**  
**Carl Sandburg College**

1. GED instruction is available at no charge to the student. No additional fees are charged to the sponsoring school district.
2. Instruction is provided through **a combination of two-way interactive video, on-line instruction, and videotaped programming on Channel 22.**
3. Instruction is appropriate for adult students, age 17 years of age and older who are not enrolled in school and who read at 8<sup>th</sup> grade level or above.
4. Instruction can be offered in 8-week segments each semester.
5. Students commit to (2) two-hour blocks each week.
6. Schools make available the two-way interactive video classroom and the television for Channel 22 programming. Students need access to on-line instruction through school computers or home computers.
7. CSC personnel meet with students to conduct intake and assessment. During the intake process, students who do not demonstrate a minimum 8<sup>th</sup> grade reading level will be referred to the CSC Literacy Coalition for assistance. EDUNET GED instruction is not appropriate for someone reading below an 8<sup>th</sup> grade level.
8. Students can prepare for all five parts of the GED exam and progress at their own pace.
